The Asia Pacific pediatric healthcare market will show the highest CAGR over the forecast time period, owing to the various improvement in the healthcare infrastructure, rising demand for chronic disease treatment, technological developments in medical devices, and the increasing children population suffering from diseases and disorders. China and Japan are dominant country-level markets in the region, whereas India is estimated to grow rapidly in the upcoming years.

The Latin American pediatrics healthcare market is expected to grow moderately in the future, owing to the growing number of disease treatment for chronic diseases and technological developments in medical devices. Brazil is expected to contribute the largest revenue share to this regional market. The Middle Eastern and African pediatrics healthcare market will register slow growth in the years ahead, owing to the underdeveloped healthcare infrastructure and lack of advanced medical technologies for treatment.

The global pediatric healthcare market is likely to grow notably, due to the exponential increase in the demand for chronic disease treatment, changes witnessed in childcare trends, increase in the obese population base due to sedentary lifestyle, rise in the number of hospitals and clinics, improvements in healthcare infrastructure in developing economies, high acceptance rate of pediatric healthcare, escalation in starvation among pediatric population, advancements in medical technology, and supportive government initiatives.
